Please apply by submitting an essay using one of the criteria listed below:

- Submit a typed essay half in English and half in Italian if you have studied Italian, are a native speaker of Italian, or have learned to speak Italian from your family. Explain how this first or second language has been a benefit to you and why this scholarship is important to you.
- Submit a typed essay between 500 and 700 words in English explaining why this scholarship is important to you and describing your interest in Italian culture. If you are of Italian heritage, explain what that means to you. If you are not of Italian heritage, do you see any similarities between your culture and the Italian culture?

Scholarships will be awarded at our Scholarship Presentation Ceremony held at Cumberland Mall on Tuesday, April 14, 2026 at 6:30 PM.
